NIA Arrests 2 more Accused in Dispur IED Recovery Case in Assam ULFA(I) Blast Conspiracy Case

New Delhi, 17th July 2025

The National Investigation Agency (NIA) has arrested two more accused in connection with the recovery of an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) planted by the ULFA (I) terror group at Dispur Last Gate, Guwahati, as part of a conspiracy to carry out multiple blasts in Assam on Independence Day in 2024.

Residents of Dibrugarh district of Assam, the accused, Bhargob Gogoi and Sumu Gogoi, were directly involved in the conspiracy orchestrated by the proscribed terrorist organization to strike terror and threaten the sovereignty, security, and integrity of the nation. With their arrest, the total number of accused arrested in the case RC-03/2024/NIA-GUW has gone up to three.

NIA, which took over the investigation into the case from Dispur police in September last year, had last month chargesheeted three accused in the case under various sections of BNS, UA(P) Act and The Explosives Substance Act.

Investigations in the case are continuing.
