NIA ARRESTS 2 ACCUSED AFTER SEARCHES IN W. BENGAL IN A MINOR BANGLADESHI GIRL'S TRAFFICKING CASE

New Delhi, 21st September 2025

The National Investigation Agency (NIA) on Saturday searched five locations in Kolkata and Bangaon areas of West Bengal and arrested two accused namely, Amir Ali Shekh and Amal Krishna Mondal, both hailing from North 24 Pargana, in human trafficking case pertaining to a minor victim from Bangladesh. The victim was illegally trafficked to India on the pretext of employment, and was forced into exploitation.

The searches operation has resulted in the seizure of a huge amount of Indian and Bangladeshi and other foreign currencies and several incriminating documents.

With the latest arrests and seizures, NIA has taken a significant step further towards dismantling the human trafficking network engaged in trafficking Bangladeshi girls into India from across the border. The agency is continuing with its investigation in the case.
