2 MORE CHARGESHEETED BY NIA IN CPI (MAOIST) JHARKHAND TERROR CONSPIRACY CASE

New Delhi, 26th September 2025

The National Investigation Agency (NIA) has chargesheeted two more accused in a CPI (Maoist) terror conspiracy case relating to seizure of gelatine sticks and other incriminating material in Jharkhand.

The accused have been identified as Jaipal Deogam of West Singhbhum district of Jharkhand and Budru Padam @ Rohit Padam of Bijapur district of Chhattisgarh. The second supplementary chargesheet filed today before the NIA Spl. Court, Ranchi, has charged them under various sections of IPC and UA(P) Act.

NIA had seized cash amounting to Rs. 10,50,000, walkie-talkie sets, Samsung tablet, power bank, radio set, levy collection receipt, pull through, gelatine sticks and other incriminating things, found buried in the forest area lying between villages Husipi and Rajabhasa in West Singhbhum.

The seizures were made on the basis of the disclosures of accused Rajesh Deogam, who was chargesheeted by NIA in July 2025. Earlier, the local police had registered the case against five persons in March 2024.

The two accused chargesheeted today were active cadres of the proscribed CPI (Maoist) terrorist organisation, as per NIA investigations. They were found involved in a conspiracy to commit terrorist acts, and were engaged in organising meetings and extorting money from contractors and traders, and in handling arms for the outfit. The ACCUSED also provided shelter to armed cadres of CPI (Maoist) as part of the conspiracy aimed at furthering the terror and criminal activities of the organisation.

NIA is continuing to probe the case.
