NIA CHARGESHEETS CPI (MAOIST) OPERATIVE FOR INCITING MOB TO PROMOTE TERROR OUTFIT'S ACTIVITIES.

New Delhi, 18th June 2026

The National Investigation Agency (NIA) on Thursday chargesheeted a key CPI (Maoist) operative for inciting a mob at a funeral of a deceased member of the proscribed terrorist organisation to promote unlawful activities.

In the chargesheet filed before the NIA special court at Nampally, Hyderabad, Gade Innaiah @ Gade Inna Reddy has been charged under relevant sections of BNS, 2023 and UA(P)A, 1967. The chargesheet is based on various technical and other evidence collected by NIA during investigation in the case RC 04/2025/NIA/HYD.

NIA had found the accused, who was arrested in December 2025, to have made certain incriminating remarks at the funeral meeting of a deceased Central Committee Member of CPI (Maoist), Katha Ramachandra Reddy, in October 2025. Gade had incited a gathering of around 200 people at the funeral meeting by urging them to actively promote the ideology of CPI (Maoist) and never let the revolution die. The accused had also lambasted erstwhile CPI (Maoist) cadres who had surrendered their weapons before government agencies.

NIA investigation had revealed that Gade was closely associated with several senior cadres of CPI (Maoist) and used to meet them in the jungle areas of Chhattisgarh. He was further found to be actively involved in propagating the terror outfit's ideology through a frontal organisation - 'Bharat Bachao', of which he was a co-founder.

Investigation in the case is continuing.
