16. BRIEF OF THE CASE

This case pertains to a planned attack by about 100-150 cadres of banned terrorist outfit CPI (Maoist) on road opening party of 80th Bn CRPF and local police, at NH-30 near village Tahakwada, on 11/03/2015. The Road Opening Party, comprising 43 personnel (30 of F-Coy, 80th Bn CRPF and 13 police personnel posted at PS- Tongpal), was deputed to sanitize the area for troops movement and to provide security to road construction workers.

The ROP left PS- Tongpal at about 0900 hours in 3 sections. When the 1st section reached about 04 Km ahead of Police station Tongpal towards Darbha, at about 1030 hours near village Tahakwada, Maoist cadres of Darbha division, led by Surendra, Deva, Vinod, Sonadhar, ambushed the road opening party. The exchange of fire took place for about an hour. Firing and IED explosions resulted into killing of 15 force personnel (11 CRPF personnel and 4 state policemen) and severe injury to other 3 personnel. One civilian, passing by, was also killed. Maoists looted the personnel belongings and weapons of deceased and injured personnel which include six AK 47 rifle (three amongst them were with UBGL), one INSAS LMG, eight INSAS and two SLR. The Maoist left the spot after looting the weapons.

On written complaint of [REDACTED] a case was registered at Police Station Tongpal, District-Sukma as case crime No 16/14 dated 11/03/2014 under section 147, 148, 149, 307, 302, 396, 397 IPC, section 25, 27 Arms Act and section 10(B), 13(A), 16,20,23 and 38(2) UA(P) Act against Sonadhar, Shankar, Sanna, Surendra, Ganesh Uike, Raghu, Sukhram, Vinod, Sumitra, Deva, Pajja, Jamili, Masa, Naresh, Anil, Hidme, Deve, Lakki, Jogi, Budhram and approximately 150-200 other active cadres of proscribed organization CPI(Maoist).

As per the Ministry of Home Affairs order Number F. No.11011/17/2014-IS.IV dated 21/03/2014, NIA has registered RC- 01-2014/NIA/DLI Dated 28.03.2014, corresponding to the case crime No 16/14 dated 11/03/2014 of PS- Tongpal and took over the investigation.

17. Facts disclosed during investigation :

- 17.1- It is evident that that Communist Party of India (Maoist) [*CPI(Maoist)*] is a proscribed terrorist outfit in India as declared in 1st Schedule of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act 1967 as amended, and mentioned in the aforementioned schedule.
- 17.2- A brief introduction to the CPI (Maoist) will help in appreciating the evidences gathered against the accused persons during the investigation. All the accused persons are members of CPI(Maoists).

Brief History of CPI (Maoist):-

- I. The Communist Party of India (Maoist) aims to overthrow the democratically elected Government of India through self-proclaimed people's war and to establish a new social order. It was founded on 21 September 2004, through the merger of two terrorist organizations namely (i) the Communist Party of India (Marxist-Leninist) People's War (People's War Group), and (ii) the Maoist Communist Centre of India (MCCI). The merger was announced on 14th October, 2004. Consequent upon merger, a provisional Central Committee of CPI (Maoist) was constituted with the erstwhile People's War Group leader Muppala Lakshmana Rao @ Ganpati as General Secretary.
- II. The party hierarchy consists of a Central Committee (CC), Regional Bureaus, Special Zonal Committee / State Committees, Regional Committees, the Divisional Committees, Area Committees, Local Organizational Squad/ Local Guerrilla Squad, Jan Militias and dalams. Apart from dalam members, all other members of organization are full time members.
- III. Central Committee is divided into 5 bureaus viz (1) South West Regional Bureau (SWRB), comprising State of Karnataka, Kerala and Tamilnadu (2) North Regional Bureau (NRB)

comprising of J & K, Punjab, Haryana, Delhi, UP and UK (3) Central Regional Bureau (CRB) comprising of Chhattisgarh-Odisha Border Special Zonal Committee (COBSZC), Dandakaranya Special Zonal Committee (DKSZC), Andhra Odisha Border Special Zonal Committee (AOBSZC), North Telangana Special Zonal Committee (NTSZC) and Maharashtra SC, (4) Eastern Regional Bureau (ERB) consisting of West Bengal State Committee (WBSC), Bihar-Jharkhand Special Area Committee (BJSAC), Odisha State Organizing Committee (ORSOC) and Assam Leading Committee (for North Eastern States) (5) Central Propaganda Bureau (CPB). Regional Bureaus are essentially headed by a Central Committee member.

- IV. The CRB is being headed by a CC member Katakam Sudershan @ Anand and he is assisted by other senior cadres. CRB is considered to be one of the most strongholds of CPI (Maoist). It has its own Central Regional Command (CRC), a purely military unit, headed by Thippiri Tirupathi @ Deoji, another CC member.
 - V. The Naxal structure in Dandakaranya Special Zonal Committee (DKSZC) region consists of Regional Unified Commands. DKSZC is divided into 3 Regional Unified Command which is further divided into 8 Divisional committee. Three Regional Commands includes: - (1) North Regional Unified Command (NRUC) having jurisdiction over Divisional committess of Maad-North Bastar, Manpur, Rajnandgoan-Kanker Border, and East Bastar (2) South Regional Unified Command (SRUC) having jurisdiction over Divisional committess of South Bastar, West Bastar C, Darbha and (3) West Regional Unified Command (WRUC) having jurisdiction over Divisional committess of South Gadchiroli and North Gadchiroli. DKSZC is headed by Ravula Srinivas @ @ Ramanna.
 - VI. Investigation brought out that South Regional Unified Command is controlled by Maoists namely (1) Thippiri Tirupathi @ Deoji (Incharge of SRUC from CC) (2) Paka Hanumanthu @ Uike Ganesh (I/c of West Bastar DVC) (3) G. Pavananda Reddy @Shyam (I/c Darbha DVC) (4) Kalpana @ Mainakka (I/c of South Bastar DVC) (5) Hidma (Member SRUC and In Charge of 1st Bn) (6) Venkatesh (In Charge of military Coy No-2) (7) Surender (Secretary Darbha Division) (8) Vyugula Aruna @ Madhavi (Secretary of West Baster DVC) (9) Kukati Venkataiah @Raghu.
 - VII. Investigation revealed that DKSZC member G.Pavananda Reddy @Shyam is in charge of Darbha Division Committee and Surendra is Secretary of Darbha Division Committee. Apart from them, Darbha Division Committee have its member namely (1) Barse Sukka @ Deva, (2) Sappo Hunga @ Vinod, (3) Kishore Karram @ Sonadhar, (4) Nirmala Secretary of Malangir Area committee (5) Sukhram Secretary of Katekalyan Area Committee. Darbha Division Committee is further subdivided into 3 area Committees viz (a) Katekalyan Area Committee (b) Kanger Valley Area Committee and (c) Malenger Area Committee. These area committees have their own LOS and LGS. Jan Militias and Sangham Members are also the part of basic setup of Maoists.
- 17.3- Investigation has established that the ambush on the road opening party of the CRPF and police personnel, was part of the conspiracy to eliminate the Security Forces in the area of the Tahakwada of PS-Tongpal. Such terrorist attacks are the part of the Tactical Counter Offensive Campaign (TCOC) conducted by the Maoists. TCOC is a declared party mandate and well planned activity of Maoists organised from the month of December to June every year. During this period the party cadres are mobilised and carryout terror attacks on security personnel and government

establishments in various guerrilla zones in order to annihilate police personnel and to loot their weapons. They also demolish government institutions under area of their dominance like schools and railway tracks, Police stations and other offices. They try their best to keep the areas under their control away from modernity and development, typically the uneducated rural populace, in the apprehension that developed population may not support their cause. Such TCOC operations serve two purpose, it causes loss of life and property to the democratic government and, at the other hand, strikes terror in mind of local people who are forced to help Maoists. At the end of TCOC, review meetings are conducted at every level, from regional committees to Central Committee, for analysing the outcome of TCOC.

- 17.4- It has been brought out in investigation that, one Company of 80 Battalion CRPF is deployed at PS-Tongpal and at PS-Darbha in this area and they conduct various area dominance patrolling and other operational activities assisted by other additional forces of District force. The area of PS-Tongpal covers some parts of the Kanger Ghati area. The Maoists have establish an organised setup in the Kanger Ghati area and have made their effective presence in last few years. They have established kanger Ghati Area committee headed by Sonadhar under its Darbha Division. It has Kanger Ghati LOS and LGS. The Maoists have established their basic setup of Sangham and Jan Militias in the villages of Kanger Gahti area. The Maoists have successfully ambushed convoy of Pariartan Yatra on 25.05.2013 in Darbha area. Since then the security forces including CRPF and Local Police have enhanced their activities in the area and they have been able to reduce the dominance of the Maoists in the area.
- 17.5- Investigation has established that conspiracy to attack the Police and CRPF personnel in Tahakwada area was hatched during the meeting of senior cadres of Divisional Committee of Darbha division of CPI (Maoist). The meeting was held in the month of February 2014 in forest area of Aranpur. This area comes under the dominance of Malangir Area Committee of Darbha Division. The accused person Surendra (A-1), Deva (A-2), Vinod (A-3), Sonadhar (A-11) and Shyam, Sukhram, Massa, Sukhram, Ganga, Anil, Jagdish, Shyamla with other unknown accused persons participated in the meeting. All cadres assembled in the area at the call of the Shyam and Surendra. During the meeting the operational and non-operational issues were discussed that includes carrying attacks on police and security forces.
- 17.6- Investigation has established that in order to reassert their presence accused Vinod (A-3) and Sonadhar (A-11) proposed to ambush the patrolling parties of the Police and CRPF in the area of Tahakwada as the area has sufficient cover of forest and suitable topography for such attacks. The Darbha division Secretary Surendra (A-1) approved the plan after the discussion with the other senior cadres and division committee members. Accused Vinod (A-3) and Sonadhar (A-11) were given task to recce the area and choose a suitable place for ambush. Such type of the ambush are part of TCOC approved by the senior leadership at the level of Regional Command. Darbha division comes under the South Regional Committee headed by Maoist Ganesh Uike.
- 17.7 After the meeting, accused Sonadhar (A-11), Vinod (A-3), Deva (A-2) and other Maoists Sukhram, Shyamla, Ganga and Nirmala returned to their areas and started preparation of the ambush. The accused persons conducted meeting of Local Organisational and Guerrilla Squads in respective area

and asked their cadres to remain ready for a big incident and also asked to collect logistics through the Jan Militias and local villagers which come under their area of influence.

- 17.8- Investigation has brought out that accused persons Sonadhar (A-11), Vinod (A-3), Massa, Shankar and other cadres conducted recce of the area and selected the incident site as suitable place. Darbha Division Committee member Vinod (A-3) sent details to Secretary of Darbha Division Surendra (A-1). Surendra (A-1) and Shyam decided to conduct the ambush after the final approval of South Regional Committee head Ganesh Uike, since such big ambush, being part of TCOC, require the approval of senior leadership. Accordingly, Surendra sent the message to Sonadhar (A-11), Vinod (A-3), and Deva (A-2) Kesha, Sukhram, Ganga, Aaytu and other cadres to assemble at designated places and further to reach in the forest areas of Tahakwada forests by evening of 09.03.2014.
- 17.9- Investigation has brought out that about five days before the incident the accused Surendra (A-1) was camping in the area of Pordem. He was accompanied with Maoist cadre Kesha of Kerlapal area, Aaytu of Malangir area, cadres of platoon 24 and 26 led by Anil and Jagdish, and some cadres of Katekalyan area. There were about 40-50 cadres. They further moved towards the forest areas of Tahakwada via Nangel, Kodripal, Gorli, Dabba, Kunna, Marjum, Tirathgarh. Accused Deva (A-2) joined the group in Gorli. In Marjum the cadres and jan militias of Katekalyan led by Ganga and in Tirathgarh Maoist Sukhram joined them with his cadres and some jan Militias. The whole group of 50-60 cadres and 20-30 Jan Militias reached forest areas of Tahakwada by the evening of 09.03.2014. This group included armed Maoists of Katekalyan, Kerlapal and Malangir Area Committee and members of Platoon 24 and 26 and jan-militias of this area coming under the Darbha division.
- 17.10- Investigation has established that another group of the Maoists of Kangergahti Area led by accused Sappo Hunga @ Vinod (A-3), Kishore Karram @ Sonadhar (A-11), Shaymla, Shankar after returning from the Divisional committee meeting in Feb 2014 mobilised their cadres and Jan Militias, collected logistics including eatable materials. Sonadhar (A-11) directed Jan Militia commanders Mahadev Nag (A-4), Joga Kawasi (A-5), Dayaram Baghel (A-6), Mani Ram Madiya @ Boti (A-7), Umesh Madkami (A-8), Kunjami Sanna (A-9) Lakshman Korram(A-10), Kawasi Lakhma, Mangdu to assemble their dalam members and other local villagers at Badhanpal for some important work. Accordingly accused Mahadev Nag(A-4), Joga Kawasi (A-5), Dayaram Baghel (A-6), Mani Ram Madiya @ Boti (A-7), Umesh Madkami (A-8), Kunjami Sanna (A-9), Lakshman Korram(A-10), Kawasi Lakhma, and Mangdu assembled the local villagers and dalam memebrrs from the area of Koleng, Chandameta, Kandanaar, Elengnaar, Chiurwada, Chidpal, Kumakoleng and adjoining areas and took them along to the forest area of Badhanpal.
- 17.11- Investigation has brought out that accused Sappo Hunga @ Vinod (A-3), Kishore Karram @ Sonadhar (A-11), Shankar, Massa got assembled their armed cadres, local Jan Militias and dalam members in the forest area of the Badhanpal on Sunday, 09.03.2014. About 30-40 armed Maoist cadres and 25-30 Jan Militias moved to the forest areas of Kankapal. They reached there by the evening of 09.03.2014. The group camped there and took assistance of local villagers and Jan Militias in transporting the food items and other logistics. However the most of the Jan Militias remain unidentified.

- 17.12- Investigation has further established that about 100 armed Maoist cadres and 30-40 Jan Militias assembled in two groups on both sides of Sukma-Jagdalpur NH221 road, in the Forest areas of Tahakwada and Kankapal on the evening of 09.03.2014. The Maoists were armed with sophisticated weapons like SLR, INSAS, AK-47, and 303 Rifles etc. The Maoist cadres led by accused Surendra (A-1), Deva (A-1), Kesha, Sukhram, Anil, Jagdish, Lingey and others camped in forest areas of Tahakwada near the Jheerum Nallah while the Maoists cadres led by Vinod (A-3), Sonadhar (A-11), Massa, Shankar camped at Tahakwada side at safer places.
- 17.13- Investigation has brought out that the accused Surendra (A-1), Deva (A-2), Sukhram, Kesha, Aaytu, Sukhram, Ganga, Sonadhar (A-11), Shankar, Shyamla and Massa conducted a meeting at the camp of Kankapal same evening. During the meeting it was decided that the whole group would be divided into 05 Sections led by Surendra (A-1), Kesha, Vinod (A-3), Sonadhar (A-11) and Shankar respectively. The Section led by Shankar was further divided into 02 Sub-sections as it was to be deployed on both sides of the road. Shankar was commanding cadres deployed towards Kankapal side while Massa was commanding cadres towards the west side of the roads. Accused Surendra (A-1), Kesha, Vinod (A-3), Sonadhar (A-11) and Shankar divided the cadres in their respective Sections and made some groups as main assault groups which was to fire on the police personnel. Reserve group, sentry group for the all sides, scouts-stops and medical teams. Scouts were under Surendra (A-1) and Deva (A-2), Stops were under Shankar and Massa and were marked for Darbha side. The medical team was with Surendra.
- 17.14- Investigation has established that recce party which included Deva (A-2), Soandhar (A-11), Lingey, Massa, Mahadev (A-4) and Joga Kawasi (A-5) also laid improvised explosive devices along the culvert at the incident site in the night of 09.03.2014. These IEDs were exploded during the ambush by the accused Deva (A-2) and others. As per the reports of FSL Raipur, traces of Ammonium Nitrate were found from sample of IED and sample soil of incident scene.
- 17.15- Investigation has brought out that the Maoists cadres were divided in Sections for the ambush in following manner:-
- Section-01 Commander was Vinod (A-3) – Along with him other cadres were Pojja, Balsingh, Lallu, Bhima, Ganga, Masso, Lokesh, Sajanti, Dasri, and group of Mallesh having 05-07 cadres, Jan Militias Mahadev(A-4), Keru, Arjun and some other Dalam/Sangham Members. The cadres with AK-47, SLR, 303 and Bharmar guns were in main assault group. The unarmed Jan militias and some others were in reserve group. The Section took position on the eastern side of the road; in the middle of the Sections of Sonadhar and Shankar.
 - Section-02 Commander was Sonadhar (A-11). Along with him Sukka, Raja @ Lakshman, Kanna, Bahadur, Naresh, Aayta, Massey, Deve, Jamili, Hidme, Raje, Dashmi and Suki Lakshman (A-10), Boti (A-7) of Chandameta, Dayaram(A-6), Kunjami Sanna (A-9) were among the main assault group and reserve groups while Lakhmu, Mangdu, Chainu were the others. This Section took position along the eastern side of the road towards Tahakwada side.
 - Section 03 was headed by Shankar and assisted by Massa as it was deployed on both sides of the road. Baman, Diwan, Dasru, Bandi, Munni, Lakki, Ganga, Samli, Gangi, Budhri, Umesh (A-8), Aaytu, Lachhhu were with Shankar while Shyamla, Kamli, Hunga, Sushila, Guddu,

Bagha, Pisso, Kummey, Phulo, Somari and Lachchhi were with Massa. This Section took position on both sides of the road. The group of Shankar was on the eastern side of the road and group of the Massa was on the western side of the road. This Section was deployed towards the northern side of the ambush area along the road.

- Section 04 was headed by Surendra (A-1) and assisted by Platoon 24 headed by Anil. Linga, Bhima, Sukka, Hidma and group of Aayta of Malangir including Joga, Manoj, Hadma, Sonu, Mandvi, Sukka and Kumma, Gundadhur, Kosa, Deve, Hidma, Mango Sonu, Sanni, Chhota Shankar, Ganga, Budhra, Bhima ,Budra, Joga (A-5) and some other cadres and jan Militias were with him. This Section took position on western side of the road. It was on the southern side of the ambush area. Main ambush party took position along the bunds of the fields and along the trees.
- Section 05 was headed by Kesha @ Sanju and assisted by Mukka and other 08-10 cadres of Kerlapal area. Accused Deva(A-2) also placed himself in this Section. Lingey, commander of platoon 26, and cadres including Kosi, Badru, Malti, Bandu, Hidma, Jamli, Pandu, Nandey, Nandaa, Chinga, Hunga, Hurra, Sudru, Bhimey Sukdi, Jagdish, Mangtu, Budhri, Magli, Sanni, Massey, Ramey, Hidma. This Section took position on western side of the road and along the middle area of ambush. They also took positions along the bunds of fields and trees.
- Ramesh, Sukka, Ungi, Lakhma and some local dalam/sangham members were in the medical team.
- Scouts were detailed towards the Tongpal side with the wireless sets to inform the ambush party about the movement of the Police forces. After performing scout duty, the team joined main assault group and a few joined the reserve party.
- The medical team was with Surendra.

17.16- Investigation has established that the Maoists laid the ambush on 10.03.2014 but they had to withdraw that day as there was no movement of the Security Forces. The Maoist parties stayed behind the ambush area. The scouts and sentries remained deployed.

17.17- Investigation has established that on 11.03.14 at about 0900 hrs, the Road Opening Party (ROP) consisting of 43 personnel including 30 personnel of CRPF and 13 of district police moved from Police Station Tongpal for duty towards Darbha side. The ROP was going to border of PS- Tongpal and Darbha which is about the 07 kms from PS-Tongpal. ROP was to be deployed from Tahakwada area upto the border of PS-Tongpal covering about 3-4 kilometers stretch. The ROP consisted of following 43 personnel-

- 17.18- Investigation has brought out that some local villagers went to *Jheerum Nalah* for construction of a temple in the morning of 11.03.2014. They were confronted with 25-30 armed Maoists who asked them to leave immediately. The Maoists further warned them not to disclose their presence to police. Frightened villagers left the place immediately. While returning they met the ROP of CRPF and Tongpal police but did not tell them about presence of Maoists due to fear.
- 17.19- Investigation has established that as the ROP moved about 01 km off Tahakwada, the Maoists were alert. Their scouts informed them of movement of the force personnel. Two of the forward moving force personnel Inspector Subhash and Cons Neeraj Singh stopped at a place within ambush area and when 15-20 force personnel came in the ambush area the armed group of Shankar, Vinod (A-3) and Sonadhar (A-11) opened fire. One group of stop party put three vehicles to fire on Darbha side of the road.
- 17.20- Investigation has established that the group of Surendra (A-1), Kesha, Sonadhar (A-11), Vinod (A-3) and Shankar fired on the police personnel of the main ambush area and also upon the other police and CPPF personnel. Stunned by sudden attack, Police personnel tried to return the fire but lack of cover made their effort ineffective. 15 police personnel were killed and 03 were seriously injured. One civilian who came in the area of the ambush got killed by the firing of Maoists.
- 17.21- Investigation has established that the teams of Sonadhar (A-11), Vinod (A-3), Surendra (A-1) and Shankar with co-accused persons moved ahead and snatched the weapons, ammunitions and some personal belongings of the force personnel. The accused persons also fired on the police personnel from close ranges and hit them with the butt of Rifles. Other Maoist cadres continued to engage the remaining police and CRPF personnel and fired on them, due to which they could not advance and by this time Maoists had killed 15 force personnel and looted their weapons, ammunitions and personal items.
- 17.22- Investigation has established that the Maoist moved back in the respective directions in the forest of Kankapal and Tahakwada. The Maoists group led by Surendra (A-1), Deva (A-2), Kesha, Sukhram and others moved to the forest areas of Marjum while group of Vinod (A-3), Sonadhar (A-11), Massa, Mallesh and other moved towards forest area of Kanger Ghati. The Jan militias went back to their respective villages after handing over the looted articles to Maoists.
- 17.23- Investigation has established that the reinforcement party of police reached the spot and evacuated the victims and injured. The FIR was lodged on the written complaint of the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] 21 named and 150 un-named Maoist cadres on 11.03.2014 as FIR no 16/14 of PS-Tongpal.

- 17.24- Investigation has established that Maoist cadre Sonadhar (A-11) and Vinod (A-3) conducted public meeting in Badhanpal on 12.03.2014 and in area of Chandameta of Kanger valley 14.03.2014. The meeting was attended by local villagers wherein the Maoist cadres informed the villagers about their act and showed the looted weapons. A-11 organized some more meetings in the area of Chiurwada, Chidpal and Badhanpal. He addressed the local villagers and told them about his involvement in the incident. The looted weapons were also shown to the local villagers. Purpose of such meetings was just to terrorize the local villagers by revealing to them that the Maoists could easily kill Security Forces and the only guarantee for safety of local people is to follow the dictates of Maoists.
- 17.25- Investigation has established that a review meeting was conducted in Munga in Marjum and Chikpal area after 04 days of the incident. The review meeting was attended by the SZC member Shyam and cadres of Darbha division including Surendra (A-1), Deva (A-2), Vinod (A-3), Kesha, Shankar, Sukhra, Massa, Shyamla, Aaytu, Ganga, Kiran, Anil, Lingey and some other cadres who were part of the ambush. In the meeting entire incident was narrated in detail by Surendra (A-1) and Deva (A-2). SZC member Shyam appreciated the role of Maoists. The looted weapons were taken to South Sukma area by Kesha @ Sanju; however some of the weapons remained with Darbha division.
- 17.26- During investigation, empty rounds of AK-47, INSAS, SLR, 12 bore gun, .303 rifles and UBGL, live IEDs, wires etc were seized from the Scene of the crime. The articles were sent to FSL Raipur and RFSL Jagdalpur for analysis. Soil sample from the SoC was also collected and sent to FSL. Forensic reports confirm use of explosive substances in the incident.
- 17.27- Investigation has brought out that 16 persons died and 03 got injured in the ambush carried out by accused Maoist cadres. Detail of deceased persons is as follows:

In the incident Maoists also looted 06 AK-47, 03 UBGL, 08 INSAS Rifles, 01 INSAS LMG, 02 SLR Rifles, 01 GPS set and some other personal belongings of the victims.

- 17.28- Investigation has brought out that the *post mortem* reports of the deceased persons confirmed death due to haemorrhage caused by the multiple firearm injuries. The medico-legal report of the injured persons confirms gunshot injury.
- 17.29- Investigation has established that the accused Maoists Cadres Soma Sodhi @ Surendra (A-1) Barse Sukka @ Deva @ Devanna (A-2), Sappo Hunga @ Vinod (A-3) and Kishore Karram @ Sonadhar (A-11) and their associate cadres mobilised and assembled other subordinate armed cadres and Jan Militias in Forest areas of Tahakwada and laid the ambush. The Armed Cadres looted the weapons and ammunitions of the Security Forces after killing them in cold blooded manner.
- 17.30- Investigation has established that as per the directions of accused A-3 and A-11, the armed Jan Militia commanders Mahadev Nag (A-4), Joga Kawasi (A5), Dayaram Baghel (A-6), Mani Ram Madiya @ Boti (A-7), Umesh Madkami (A-8), Kunjami Sanna (A-9) and Lakshman Korram (A-10) further mobilised local villagers and Dalam/Sangham members and took them to forest area of Badhanpal and further to incident place. Some of the unwilling villagers were taken forcefully to the incident place. The Maoist cadres Sukhram and Ganga of Katekalyan area also mobilised the Jan Militias and local villagers who, assisted them in transporting logistics, arranging and making foods etc.
- 17.31- Investigation has established that the accused persons Surendra (A-1), Deva (A-2), Sappo Vinod (A-3), Mahadev Nag (A-4), Joga Kawasi (A-5), Dayaram Baghel (A-6), Mani Ram Madiya @ Boti (A-7), Umesh Madkami (A-8), Kunjami Sanna (A-9), Lakshman Korram (A-10) and Sonadhar (A-11) had participated in the ambush and had fired on the Force personnel to kill them.

- 17.32 Accused A-1, A-2, A-3, A-8, A-9, A-10 and A-11 are still absconding despite best efforts to apprehend them. Accused A-4, A-5, A-7 are lodged in Jagdalpur jail and A-6 in Dantewada jail, in connection with other cases. Warrant to produce them was issued by Special NIA Court, Bilaspur.
- 17.33- The investigation has established that Soma Sodhi @ Surendra (A-1), as an armed member of the proscribed terrorist organisation of the CPI (Maoists) and in the capacity of Secretary of its Darbha division, entered into a criminal conspiracy with A-2, A-3, A-11 & other unidentified accused to carryout terror attack on Security Force personnel in Tahakwada area. In pursuance of said conspiracy, A-1, in association with other identified and unidentified co-conspirators including but not limited to A-2, A-3, A-4, A-5, A-6, A-7, A-8, A-9, A-10, A-11 laid the ambush, exploded IEDs, fired on the Security Force Personnel by his illegally obtained AK-47 rifle. The ambush resulted in killing of 16 persons and seriously injuring 03 more.
- 17.34- The investigation has established that Barse Sukka @ Deva @ Devanna (A-2), as an armed member of the proscribed terrorist organisation of the CPI (Maoists) and in the capacity of Commander in chief of military platoons 24 & 26 and member of its Darbha division, entered into a criminal conspiracy with A-1, A-3, A-11 & other unidentified accused to carryout terror attack on Security Force personnel in Tahakwada area. In pursuance of said conspiracy, A-2, in association with other identified and unidentified co-conspirators including but not limited to A-1, A-3, A-4, A-5, A-6, A-7, A-8, A-9, A-10, A-11 laid the ambush, exploded IEDs, fired on the Security Force Personnel by his illegally obtained AK-47 rifle. The ambush resulted in killing of 16 persons and seriously injuring 03 more.
- 17.35- The investigation has established that Sappo Hunga @ Vinod (A-3), as an armed member of the proscribed terrorist organisation of the CPI (Maoists) and in the capacity of Member of its Darbha division, entered into a criminal conspiracy with A-1, A-2, A-11 & other unidentified accused to carryout terror attack on Security Force personnel in Tahakwada area. In pursuance of said conspiracy, A-3, in association with other identified and unidentified co-conspirators including but not limited to A-1, A-2, A-4, A-5, A-6, A-7, A-8, A-9, A-10, A-11 laid the ambush, exploded IEDs, fired on the Security Force Personnel by his illegally obtained AK-47 rifle. The ambush resulted in killing of 16 persons and seriously injuring 03 more.
- 17.36- The investigation has established that Mahadev Nag (A-4), as an armed member of the proscribed terrorist organisation of the CPI (Maoists) and in the capacity of Jan Militia commander of Kandanaar area of kanger gahti which comes under its Darbha division mobilised Jan Militias and Local villagers along with A-5, A-7 and A-10, as per the directions of A-11. A-4, in association with other identified and unidentified co-conspirators including but not limited to A-1, A-2, A-3, A-5, A-6, A-7, A-8, A-9, A-10, A-11 laid the ambush, exploded IEDs, fired on the Security Force Personnel by his illegally obtained muzzle loading (Bharmar) gun. The ambush resulted in killing of 16 persons and seriously injuring 03 more.
- 17.37- The investigation has established that Joga Kawasi (A5), as an armed member of the proscribed terrorist organisation of the CPI (Maoists) and in capacity of Jan militia member Koleng are of its Darbha division, mobilised Jan Militias and Local villagers along with A-4, A-7 and A-10 as per the

directions of A-11. A-5, in association with other identified and unidentified co-conspirators including but not limited to A-1, A-2, A-3, A-4, A-6, A-7, A-8, A-9, A-10, A-11 laid the ambush, exploded IEDs, fired on the Security Force Personnel by his illegally obtained muzzle loading (Bharmar) gun. The ambush resulted in killing of 16 persons and seriously injuring 03 more.

17.38- The investigation has established that Dayaram Baghel (A-6), as an armed member of the proscribed terrorist organisation of the CPI (Maoists) and in the capacity of Jan Militia member of Kumakoleng area of Kanger gahti which comes under its Darbha division, mobilised Jan Militias and Local villagers, as per the directions of A-11. A-6, in association with other identified and unidentified co-conspirators including but not limited to A-1, A-2, A-3, A-4, A-5, A-7, A-8, A-9, A-10, A-11 laid the ambush, fired on the Security Force Personnel by his illegally muzzle loading (Bharmar) gun. The ambush resulted in killing of 16 persons and seriously injuring 03 more.

17.39- The investigation has established that Mani Ram Madiya @ Boti (A-7), as an armed member of the proscribed terrorist organisation of the CPI (Maoists) and in the capacity of Jan militia member Koleng are of its Darbha division, mobilised Jan Militias and Local villagers along with A-4, A-5 and A-10, as per the directions of A-11. A-7, in association with other identified and unidentified co-conspirators including but not limited to A-1, A-2, A-3, A-4, A-5, A-6, A-8, A-9, A-10, A-11 laid the ambush, exploded IEDs, fired on the Security Force Personnel by his illegally obtained muzzle loading (Bharmar) gun. The ambush resulted in killing of 16 persons and seriously injuring 03 more.

17.40- The investigation has established that Umesh Madkami (A-8), as an armed member of the proscribed terrorist organisation of the CPI (Maoists) and in the capacity of Jan militia commnader of Chidpal area of Kanger hati which comes under Darbha division, mobilised Jan Militias and Local villagers along with A-9, as per the directions of A-11. A-8, in association with other identified and unidentified co-conspirators including but not limited to A-8, A-2, A-3, A-4, A-5, A-6, A-7, A-9, A-10, A-11 laid the ambush, exploded IEDs, fired on the Security Force Personnel by his illegally obtained muzzle loading (Bharmar) gun. The ambush resulted in killing of 16 persons and seriously injuring 03 more.

17.41- The investigation has established that Kunjami Sanna (A-9), as an armed member of the proscribed terrorist organisation of the CPI (Maoists) and in the capacity of Jan Militia commander of Chiurwada area of Kanger ghati which comes under Darbha division, mobilised Jan Militias and Local villagers along with A-8, as per the directions of A-11. A-9, in association with other identified and unidentified co-conspirators including but not limited to A-1, A-2, A-3, A-4, A-5, A-6, A-7, A-8, A-10, A-11 laid the ambush, fired on the Security Force Personnel by his illegally obtained AK-47 rifle. The ambush resulted in killing of 16 persons and seriously injuring 03 more.

17.42- The investigation has established that Lakshman Korram (A-10), as an armed member of the proscribed terrorist organisation of the CPI (Maoists) and in the capacity of Jan Militia commander of the Koleng area of its Darbha division mobilised Jan Militias and Local villagers along with A-5, A-7 as per the directions of A-11. A-10, in association with other identified and unidentified co-conspirators including but not limited to A-1, A-2, A-3, A-4, A-5, A-6, A-7, A-8, A-9, and A-11

laid the ambush, fired on the Security Force Personnel by his illegally obtained Muzzle loading (bharma) gun. The ambush resulted in killing of 16 persons and seriously injuring 03 more.

17.43- The investigation has established that Kishore Karam @ Sonadhar (A-11), as an armed member of the proscribed terrorist organisation of the CPI (Maoists) and in the capacity of Secretary of Kanger gahti Area committee of its Darbha division, entered into a criminal conspiracy with A-1, A-2, A-3, & other unidentified accused to carryout terror attack on Security Force personnel in Tahakwada area. As per his directions, A-4, A-5,A-6,A-7,A-8,A-9,A-10 mobilised the Jan militias and Local Villagers and Sangham members for the ambush. In pursuance of said conspiracy, A-11, in association with other identified and unidentified co-conspirators including but not limited to A-1,A-2, A-3, A-4, A-5, A-6, A-7, A-8, A-9, A-10 laid the ambush, exploded IEDs, fired on the Security Force Personnel by his illegally obtained SLR. The ambush resulted in killing of 16 persons and seriously injuring 03 more.

18.4- In accordance with Section 45(1) of UA (P) Act 1967, (As amended in act 35 of 2008) and as per the provisions of section 196 CrPC, the sanction for the prosecution has been accorded by the competent authority for the provisions of the UA (P) Act and IPC against the aforementioned accused person.

18.5- In accordance with Section 7 of Explosives Substances Act and Section 39 of Arms Act the sanction for the prosecution has been accorded by the competent authority for the provisions of Explosives Substances Act and Arms Act against the aforementioned accused person.

18.6- It is therefore requested that Cognizance of these aforementioned offences under the specified provisions of Law may be taken and process may be issued against the accused persons to face the trial in the case under the provisions of law of the land.
