One absconding FICN smuggler from Malda in West Bengal, arrested by NIA at Indo- Bangladesh Border.

The investigators of NIA arrested one Ripon Sk, an accused person in connection with NIA Case No. RC-06/2016/NIA/DLI from Daulatpur village, near Indo-Bangladesh international border, on 06.01.2017 at around 1930 hrs. Ripon had been earlier charge-sheeted in the said case on 15.07.16

2. The arrested accused Ripon Sk, aged around 23 years, s/o Nurul Sk @ Nurul Islam of Bapchhera area of Deonapur village, under Baishnabnagar PS, district Malda, was involved in the conspiracy for procurement and supply of the consignment of high quality Fake Indian Currency Notes (FICNs) having face value of Rs. 8 lacs to another Bangladeshi national namely Md. Anarul Islam, who was arrested just after receiving the said consignment from said Ripon Sk at Kaliachak Bazar, under Kaliachak PS, Malda on 18.01.2016. Ripon Sk had been absconding since then.
3. The arrested accused Ripon Sk was produced before the NIA Special Court on 07.01.2017 and the Court has granted him in police remand to NIA, for a period of 10 (ten) days.
