NIA files First Charge Sheet in Serial Blasts by the Base Movement

On 24th May, 2017, the NIA Hyderabad Branch has filed a Charge Sheet before the Hon'ble NIA Special Court, Bangalore in Crime No.RC-03/2016/NIA/HYD (Mysuru Court Blast Case), against 03 accused persons. The NIA re registered as RC-03/2016/NIA/HYD, the Crime No 63/2016 of Lakshmpuram Police Station of Mysuru City, Karnataka regarding a bomb explosion caused on 01.08.2016 by unknown persons at the Public Toilet Room in Court Premises, KRB Road, Chamarajapuram, Mysuru City, Karnataka, on 20.09.2016 and had taken up the case for investigation. During the investigation 5 persons namely N Abbas Ali (A-1), Samsun Karim Raja(A-2), Mohammed Ayub (A-3), Samsudheen Karuva (A-4) and Dawood Sulaiman(A-5) were arrested.

2. Following 3 accused have been charge sheeted:

- i) Nainar Abbas Ali @ Appas Ali @ Library Abbas (A-1), S/o Nainar Mohammed, Age 28 years/2016, R/o H.No.11/23, 4th street, Ismailpuram, Munisalai, Nelpettai, Madurai, under sections 16, 18, 18B, 20 of UA (P) Act, 1967 as amended, section 120B read with 465, 468 and 471 IPC, sections 3, 4 & 5 of Explosives Substances Act read with section 23 of UA (P) Act, 1967 as amended and section 120B IPC read with section 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act 1984.
- ii) M. Samsun Karim Raja @ Karim @ Abdul Karim (A-2), S/o Jainulabddin, Age 23 years/2016, R/o H.No. 44, 1st street, Manmalaimedu, K Pudur, Madurai, Tamilnadu, under sections 16, 18, 20 of UA (P) Act, 1967 as amended, sections 4(b) and 5 of Explosive Substances Act read with section 23 of UA (P) Act, 1967 as amended, section 120B IPC read with section 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act 1984.
- iii) S. Dawood Sulaiman @ Dawood Suleiman (A-5), S/o Dawood Sait Mohammed Abdullah, Age 23 years/2016, R/o H.No.4-295, Radio colony, Palavakkam, Chennai, Tamilnadu, under sections 16, 18, 20 of UA (P) Act, 1967 as amended, sections 120B,

465 of IPC, sections 3, 4 and 5 of Explosive Substances Act read with 23 of UA (P) Act, 1967 as amended, section 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act 1984.

3. The investigation has revealed that the explosion of the bomb at the Mysuru Court premises was carried out by the accused persons as part of a larger conspiracy which includes founding of the outfit Base Movement and carrying out various activities such as sending threatening letters to various Jails, Senior Government Functionaries, the Dinamalar office and the French Consulate, and carrying out blasts at five different Court premises in South India. Accused of the outfit Base Movement exploded IEDs at the Chittoor Court premises in Andhra Pradesh on 07th April 2016, at Kollam Court premises in Kerala on 15th June 2016, at the Mysuru Court premises in Karnataka on 1st August 2016, at Nellore Court premises on 12th September 2016 and at Malappuram Court in Kerala on 01st November 2016. The cases other than the Mysuru blast case are being investigated by the respective State Police agencies.

4. During the investigation, it has been established that Abbas Ali (A-1) had formed an outfit named Base Movement with the intention to further the objectives of the proscribed organization Al-Qaeda and he recruited other four accused persons with a view to commit terrorist and anti-national activities. The accused persons together conspired to conduct terrorist activities by exploding bombs at various places in the country and had targeted the Judiciary. In furtherance of that conspiracy they had assembled improvised explosive devices on many occasions and had placed them at different Court premises with the intention to terrorize people. One such occasion was the incident of the exploding of the bomb at Mysuru Court Complexes in this case on 01.08.2016, by them.

5. Further investigation u/s 173 (8) of CrPC is continued against A-3 and A-4.
