NIA Headquarter New Delhi office inaugurated by Union Home Minister

The new “Office building” of the NIA Hqrs, at New Delhi, located at opposite CGO Complex, was inaugurated today by Shri Rajnath Singh Ji, Hon’ble Union Home Minister, Govt. of India, in the presence of Shri Hansraj Gangaram Ahir, Hon’ble Minister of State for Home, Sh. Kiren Rijiju, Minister of State for Home, Shri Sharad Kumar, DG, NIA and Shri Yogesh Chandra Modi, Officer on Special Duty, NIA. The event was attended by various senior officers of the Home Ministry, Govt. of India, New Delhi, Central Armed Police Forces, NBCC and other government agencies.

2. The Ministry of Urban Development had allotted 1.0356 acres (4191 sqm) of land opposite CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi at a cost of Rs. 22.78 Lacks on 23rd December 2013 for construction of the complex of the NIA Hqrs.

3. The Ministry of Home Affairs vide their letter dated 24.12.2014 conveyed administrative approval-cum expenditure sanction for Rs. 35.13 crores for construction of the Office Complex of NIA Hqrs New Delhi. The MoU for construction of office complex was signed with the NBCC Ltd. on 29.12.2014.

4. The office complex has been constructed by the NBCC Ltd. The foundation stone of office complex NIA Hqrs New Delhi was laid by Shri Rajnath Singh, Hon’ble Union Home Minister on 10th September, 2015. The Complex comprises of Ground+8 Stories and 02 basements, with total built up area of 10600 sqm.
