NIA registers a case related to Bangladeshi terrorist organization ABT

In compliance of the MHA, Govt. of India Order dated 28th Feb 2018, NIA has re-registered case FIR No. 07/2017 dated 21.11.2017, PS STF, Kolkata, under sections 120B, 419, 467, 469 & 471 of IPC, section 25 (1) (a)/29 of Arms Act and section 14 of Foreigners Act, as NIA case RC-11/2018/NIA/DLI, on 01.03.2018. During investigation by Kolkata Police, sections 121, 121A, 122, 123 of IPC and sections 13, 16, 17, 18, 18A, 20, 38 & 40 of UA (P) Act were subsequently added.

2. Background of the case is that on 21.11 2017, STF, Kolkata Police arrested three members of Ansarullah Bangla Team (ABT) namely (i). Samsad Mia @ Tanvir @ Saiful @ Tushar Biswas (ii). Rizaul Islam @ Riyaz @ Sumon, both residents of Bangladesh and (iii). Monotosh Dey @ Mona Da resident of West Bengal. The accused persons sneaked into India illegally and procured forged Indian documents like Aadhar card, PAN card, voter identity card etc. Subsequently one more Bangladeshi national Umar Farukh @ Mahi @ Ali @ Md Aftab Khan was arrested on 28.11.2017. Ansarullah Bangla Team (ABT) is a proscribed terrorist organisation in Bangladesh.
