### **Fake Indian currency Notes recovered at NIA information**

The NIA Mumbai Branch had received a reliable information that one Dalim Mia, r/o Par Deonapur, Malda, West Bengal is involved in circulation of fake currency notes and he has supplied FICN at various places in Maharashtra, Karnataka and other parts of India. Accordingly, he was intercepted at Pune and on his disclosure searches were carried out at Chikkodi area with the help of local police in the night of 12/03/2018. During search, one Ashok Kumbar was arrested and Rs.82,000/- fake currency note were recovered from his possession. In this connection, an FIR No. 0104/2018 dated 12/03/ 2018 u/s 489B, 489C, 120B & 34 of IPC has been registered at Chikkodi PS, Chikkodi, Belgaum, Karnataka and 02 persons viz. Dalim Mia, s/o Nuhul Islam, r/o Sabdalpurchak, Par Deonapur, Malda, West Bengal and Ashok Mahadev Kumbar, Prabhuvadi Chikkodi, TQ Chikkodi, Belagavi Distt, Karnataka have been arrested.

2. The seized notes are of good quality and it is difficult for a common man to detect whether it is counterfeit or genuine. It is suspected that the notes were printed and smuggled from across the border.
