Charge-sheet filed in KCP Case RC-05/2017/NIA/DLI

Today National Investigation Agency filed a Charge-sheet in the Special NIA Court, Patiala House, New Delhi in connection with NIA Case No. RC-05/2017/NIA/DLI (KCP Case) dated 16.03.2017, against 03 accused persons namely (i) Khoirom Ranjit Singh @ Rocky @ Great Macha @ Poirei Meitei son of Late Kh. Ningthourel resident of Yairipok Top, PS Yairipok now Andro, district Imphal East Manipur, the Commander in Chief of Kangleipak Communist Party (KCP), and his associate (ii) Irungbam Sanatombi Devi daughter of Irungbam Kumar Singh resident of Pungdongbam Mamang leikai Pungdongbam Yourbang, Imphal East, Manipur and (iii)- P. Prem Kumar Meitei @ PK @ Ibomcha son of P Achau of Yairipok Top Imphal on 10/07/2017.

2. That NIA had re-registered a case FIR No. RC-05/2017/NIA/DLI, dated 16.03.2017, under Section 120B of IPC, and 20 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 arising out of case FIR No. 02/2017 dated 12 Jan 2017, registered at PS Special Cell, Delhi Police, under Section- 120B, of IPC and Section 20 of UA (P) Act, 1967, against two accused persons namely (i) Khoirom Ranjit Singh @ Rocky @ Great Macha @ Poirei Meitei son of Late Kh. Ningthourel resident of Yairipok Top, PS Yairipok now Andro, district Imphal East Manipur, the Commander in Chief of Kangleipak Communist Party (KCP), and his associate (ii) Irungbam Sanatombi Devi daughter of Irungbam Kumar Singh resident of Pungdongbam Mamang leikai Pungdongbam Yourbang, Imphal East, Manipur. While the third accused namely P. Prem Kumar Meitei @ PK @ Ibomcha was also arrested on 12.01.2017 from Manipur in the instant case due to his active involvement with the other accused persons of the instant case.

3. The charge-sheet against the accused persons has been filed under section Section 120B of IPC read with sections 17,18, 18B, 23, 38 & 40 of UA (P) Act 1967, section 3/7/25 (1A) of Arms Act and sections 5 & 6 of the Explosive Substances Act, 1908

Further investigation against the accused persons will continue under section 173(8) of the Criminal Procedure Code (CrPC).
