Judgement pronounced in case RC-04/2010/NIA/DLI (SIMI Wagamon Camp Case)

On 14.05.2018, Hon'ble Special Court for NIA Cases, Ernakulam pronounced judgement in Case RC-04/2010/NIA/DLI (SIMI Wagamon Camp Case) convicting 18 accused persons viz. 1) Saduli P (A-1) native of Kerala, 2) Hafeez Hussain (A-2) native of Karnataka, 3) Safdar Nagori (A-3) native of Madhya Pradesh, 4) P. A. Shibily (A-4) native of Kerala, 5) Mohammed Ansar P.A. (A-5) native of Kerala, 6) Abdul Sathar (A-6) native of Kerala, 7) Aamil Parwaz (A-7) native of Madhya Pradesh, 8) Mohammed Sami Bagevadi (A-11) native of Karnataka, 9) Nadeem Sayeed (A-14) native of Karnataka, 10) Mufti Abul Bashar (A-15) native of Uttar Pradesh, 11) Dr. H.A. Asadulla (A-24) native of Karnataka, 12) Kamaruddin Nagori (A-26) native of Madhya Pradesh, 13) Shakeel Ahammed (A-29) native of Karnataka, 14) Dr. Mirza Ahmed Baig (A-30) native of Karnataka, 15) Danish (A-33) native of Jharkhand, 16) Manzar Imam (A-34) native of Jharkhand, 17) Mohammed Abu Faisal Khan (A-36) native of Maharashtra and 18) Alam Jeb Afridi (A-38) native of Gujarat under section 120B of IPC & 10 (Membership of an Unlawful Association etc.) and 38 (Membership of a terrorist organization) of UAPA besides section 4 of the Explosive Substances Act. Remaining 17 accused persons who also faced trial, have been acquitted.

2. The Court has also convicted accused 1) Saduli P, 2) Hafeez Hussain, 3) Safdar Nagori, 4) P. A. Shibily, 5) Mohammed Ansar P. A., 6) Abdul Sathar, 7) Aamil Parwaz, 8) Nadeem Sayeed, 9) Dr. H. A. Asadulla, 10) Kamaruddin Nagori, 11) Shakeel Ahammed, 12) Dr. Mirza Ahmed Baig, 13) Manzar Imam u/s 20 of the UA(P) Act (Punishment for being member of a terrorist organization/gang).

3. The case was originally registered as FIR 257/2008 in PS Mundakayam, Kottayam, Kerala on 21/06/2008 u/s 120B, 122, 124A, 153A of IPC, sections 3, 5, 10 and 13 of UA (P) Act besides sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act against 43 accused persons. Investigation of the case was taken over by NIA and it was re-registered on 21.01.2010 as RC 04/2010/NIA/DLI. The case relates to a secret training camp organized by the activists of the banned terrorist organization SIMI at Thangalpara, Wagamon within the limits of Mundakayam Police Station, Kerala in December, 2007. The training camp was attended by SIMI activists from Kerala, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Jharkhand and Uttar Pradesh. The participants had engaged in physical training, firing practice, training in explosives, motorbike racing, rope climbing etc., besides classes on "jihad" in India.

4. First charge sheet was filed by NIA in this case against 30 accused persons on 13.01.2011 while the first Supplementary charge sheet was filed on 29.07.2013, against 6 accused persons on 29.07.2013 and the final Supplementary charge sheet was filed on 30.12.2015 against 38 accused persons including the 36 already charge sheeted accused under sections 120B, 122, 124A and 153A of IPC; sections 10, 13, 18, 20 and 38 of the UAPA; sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act 1959 and sections 3 and 4 of the Explosive Substances Act 1908 on 30.12.2015. One charge sheeted accused viz. Wasik Billa r/o Azamgarh, UP is still absconding while one charge sheeted accused person Mehboob @ Malik @ Guddoo r/o Khandwa, Madhya Pradesh was killed during an encounter at Bhopal in October, 2016. Another accused Abdus Subhan Qureshi @ Tawqeer r/o Mumbai was recently arrested in this case.

5. Trial of the case against 35 accused had commenced on 23.01.2017. 33 accused persons lodged in Ahmedabad, Delhi, Bhopal and Bengaluru prisons were produced through video conference while remaining 2 accused persons were produced physically. The prosecution examined 77 witnesses through whom 252 documents and 43 material objects were got exhibited, while the defence examined 3 witnesses during the trial. Special NIA Court has posted the case to 15.05.2018 for pronouncing sentence to the persons found guilty.
