**NIA files Charge sheet in case RC-02/2018/NIA/LKW**

Today (11.03.2019), NIA filed a charge-sheet in case RC-02/2018/NIA/LKW at NIA Special Court Lucknow, against 02 accused persons namely Kamruj Zaman @ Dr. Hurairah @ Kamarruddin (A-1), age about 39 yrs, s/o late Shaidul Hussain @ Ibrahim Zaman, r/o Erakapili, Near Jamunamukh Hospital, Daily Bazar Road, PO & PS Jamunamukh, distt. Hojai, Assam and absconding accused Osama Bin Javed (A-2), age about 23 yrs, s/o Javed Master r/o vill. & PS Sundar Dacchin, South Kishtwar, J&K, u/s 120B & 121A of IPC and sec 17, 18, 38 40 of UA (P) Act.

2. Case was originally registered at PS ATS, UP as Crime No 06/2018 dated 12.09.2018 against Kamruj Zaman and others u/s 13, 20 and 38 of UA (P) Act on allegations of hatching a criminal conspiracy to carry out terrorist attacks by HM cadres at different places in UP. Later this case was re-registered by NIA on 24.09.2018 and investigation taken up.

3. Investigation has established that A-1 and A-2 had joined HM and were imparted 09 months weapon training (June 2017 - March 2018) by 02 HM cadres namely Mohammad Amin @ Jahangir @ Jahagir Suroori (A-3) & Hajari @ Riyaz Ahmed (A-4), both r/o Kishtwar, in the jungles of district Kishtwar, J&K. After completion of training, A-1 was directed to set up hideouts and select targets in UP and Assam for terrorist attacks. On 8 April 2018, a photograph of A-1 brandishing an automatic AK-47 rifle emerged in social media, which was posted by Mannan Wani, slain terrorist of HM, on his Facebook account. A-1 later escaped to Bangladesh fearing his arrest. However, he was constantly in touch with A-2 and Riyaz Naikoo, HM operational commander in Kashmir, over BBM chat application. In first week of August 2018, he returned to India and stayed in Assam for some time. On 25 August 2018, on directions of A-2 and Riyaz Naikoo, he proceeded to Kanpur where he carried out reconnaissance of a few temples to carry out terror attack. He was also trying to collect arms and explosives to carry out terror activity.

4. Further investigation u/s 173(8) CrPC continues against absconding accused Jahangir, Hajari & others.
