



NIA Takes Over Case of Propagation of Jihadi Terrorism

Today in pursuance of order of MHA, Government of India, NIA has re- registered the case FIR No. 11/2021 dated 10.07.2021 at STF PS, Kolkata, West Bengal as RC- 19/2021/NIA/DLI on 06/08/2021 u/s Sec 121, 121A, 122, 123, 124A, 125 and 120B IPC and Sec. 14A (b) Foreigner Act.

2. This case relates to Bangladeshi nationals SK Shabbir, Joseph and others, who had illegally entered India and are sympathizers/members of terrorist organization. They had hatched a conspiracy along with their unknown associates to wage war by recruiting, motivating vulnerable Muslim youth against Government of India as well as neighboring Bangladesh to establish a 'Caliphate', by removing democratically elected government by means of criminal force. They were propagating their ideology and hatred in society by following, sending and sharing various Jehadi texts, posts and videos through Facebook profile named as 'sekh Sabbir'.
3. Pursuant to registration of the case, requisite actions as per law for expeditious investigation of case have been initiated.
