



NIA Special Court Ernakulam Convicts An ISIS- Daish Conspirator in ISIS Kasargod Module Case of Kerala (RC-02/2016/NIA/KOC)

Today, (17.11.2021) the Special Court for NIA Cases, Ernakulam convicted accused Nashidul Hamzafar , aged 28 years, r/o of Kalpetta, Wayanad district, Kerala u/s 120B r/w 125 IPC besides sections 38 and 39 of UA (P) Act, 1967, in RC-02/2016/NIA/KOC.

2. The case originally registered as FIR 534/ 2016 of Chandera Police Station, Kasaragod District, Kerala was re-registered by NIA on 24.08.2016 as RC 02/2016/NIA/KOC pertaining to activities of fourteen youth from Kasaragod district of Kerala who along with their families had exited India between May and July, 2016 and joined the ISIS/ Daish.

3. In pursuance to the criminal conspiracy hatched with fugitive ISIS/ Daish activist accused Abdul Rashid Abdulla besides Ashfak Majeed and others, accused Nashidul Hamzafar had exited India on 3rd October, 2017 and travelled to Muscat, Oman before travelling to Iran and had further reached Kabul, Afghanistan, where he was detained by Afghan Security Agencies during October, 2017 for illegally entering the country and attempting to join his associates, in ISIS/ Daish.

4. On 18.09.2018, NIA had arrested Nashidul Hamzafar (A-16), after the accused was deported from Kabul, Afghanistan. NIA had filed charge-sheet against him on 16.03.2019.

5. Today, the accused Nashidul Hamzafar pleaded guilty to all charges and the NIA Spl.Court convicted him. The quantum of punishment will be pronounced against him on 23.11.2021.
