**NIA Special Court, New Delhi Pronounces Sentence in Case of Kangeleipak Communist Party (KCP)
{RC-15/2017/NIA/DLI}**

Today (27.04.2022), NIA Special Judge, Patiala House Court, New Delhi pronounced sentence convicting the following accused persons in the case for the various offences under Indian Penal Code and Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967.

- i) Laishram Ranjit Meitei @ Manao @ Apik @ Tamnganba, convicted to 7 Years rigorous imprisonment and a fine of Rs 24000/- under sections 384 r/w 120B IPC, 385 r/w 120B of IPC and Sections 17, 18 & 20 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act.
- ii) Khumanthem Naobicha Singh @ Jack s/o Kh. Mani Singh, convicted to 7 Years rigorous imprisonment and a fine of Rs 24000/- under sections 384 r/w 120B IPC, 385 r/w 120B of IPC and Sections 17, 18 & 20 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act
- iii) Thoudam Chaothoi Singh @ Chingsang @ Raju s/o Th. Manichoubi Singh, convicted to 5 Years rigorous imprisonment and a fine of Rs 14000/-, under sections 384 r/w 120B IPC, 385 r/w 120B of IPC and Sections 18 & 20 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act.

2. The instant case is related to activities of terrorists belonging to proscribed terrorist organization Kangeleipak Communist Party (KCP). The accused persons were involved in hatching a conspiracy for raising funds by terrorizing and committing extortion from local persons, govt officials, independent bodies including schools, panchayats, etc. The case was initially registered as FIR No. 62/2017 dated 14.08.2017 by Special Cell Delhi Police and re-registered by NIA on 01.11.2017.

3. After investigation, a Charge-sheet was filed on 08.02.2018 and supplementary CS was filed on 22.03.2019.

4. Further trial in the case continues.
