



NIA Special Court, Mumbai Convicts and Sentences an ISIS Terrorist in Parbhani ISIL Case of Maharashtra (RC-03/2016/NIA/MUM)

Yesterday (26.05.2022), NIA Special Judge, City Civil and Sessions Court, Mumbai convicted and sentenced an accused Mohammed Shahed Khan @ Lala S/o. Khader Ali Khan, R/o. Roshan Khan Mohalla, Nr. Gol Ghumat, Parbhani, Maharashtra to 07 Years rigorous imprisonment and a fine of Rs 45,000/- under sections 13, 16, 18, 20, 38, 39 of UAP Act, section 120-B of IPC and sections 4, 5, 6 of Explosive Substance Act, 1908.

2. The case pertains to a conspiracy hatched by ISIS operatives in Syria for radicalising Indian youth through Internet wherein an IED was fabricated locally on their directions. The case was initially registered as Crime No. 08/2016 dated 14.07.2016 of ATS Police Station, Mumbai, Maharashtra and re-registered by NIA on 14.09.2016. After completing the investigation, a charge-sheet was filed on 07.10.2016. One accused Naser Bin Yafai (Chaus) S/o. Abubakar Yafai (Chaus), has already been convicted for 7 years of Rigorous Imprisonment by NIA Special Court, Mumbai on 06.05.2022 in this case.

3. Further trial in the case continues.
