



NIA Special Court, Ernakulam Convicts and Sentences Three ISIS Terrorists in ISIS Valapattanam Case of Kerala (RC-02/2017/NIA/KOC)

Yesterday (15.07.2022), NIA Special Court, Ernakulam convicted three persons in NIA case no. RC-02/2017/NIA/KOC for providing support to ISIS/ Daish. Those convicted were members of the proscribed terrorist organization and were attempting to travel out of India to join ISIS/Daish in Syria to fight for their cause.

2. The case was initially registered as FIR no. 1010/2017 dated 25.10.2017 at Valapattanam PS, Kerala and was taken over for investigation by NIA on 16.12.2017. After thorough investigation, a charge-sheet was filed by NIA on 21.04.2018 against 4 accused persons.

3. The details of sentences awarded to the three convicted accused are given as below.

- (i) Midlaj, s/o Moideen V. V., r/o Munderi, Kannur district, Kerala has been sentenced to 07 Years of Rigorous Imprisonment and fine under sections 38, 39 of UA (P) Act and 120B of IPC
- (ii) Abdul Razak, s/o K. P. Ahmed Kunji, r/o Chekkikulam, Kannur district, Kerala has been sentenced to 06 Years of Rigorous Imprisonment and fine under section 38 of UA (P) Act and 120B of IPC.
- (iii) Hamsa U. K., s/o Ibrahim, r/o Thalassery, Kannur district, Kerala has been sentenced to 07 Years of Rigorous Imprisonment and fine under section 38, 39 of UA (P) Act and 120B of IPC.

4. Further investigations in the case are in progress.
