ACCUSED CONVICTED IN NIA CASE FOR COMMISSION OF SCHEDULED OFFENCES

The Spl. NIA Court, Assam at Guwahati has convicted one accused named AsemIbotombi Singh @ Angou in NIA Case No. **RC-01/2011/NIA-GUW (Special NIA Case No. 01/2012)** for commission of scheduled offences. Accused AsemIbotombi Singh@ Angou was found guilty for his close association with People's Liberation Army (PLA), a proscribed terrorist organisation under the UA(P) Act, 1967 and his activities as a cadre of PLA and also procurement of identity documents under false identity.

2. The Spl. NIA Court, Guwahati has recorded statement of the accused AsemIbotombi Singh@ Angou, where the accused confessed his guilt. Accordingly, the Spl. NIA Court, Guwahati sentenced conviction under the provision of Section 229 Cr.PC vide order dated 18.04.2016 for the offences punishable u/s 120B, 121A, 468 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 18, 20 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 (as amended) and announced quantum of sentence/ punishment for each and every offence as under:

- i) The accused is sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 7 years u/s 120B IPC and also a fine of Rs. 5,000/- in default further imprisonment of 1 year.
- ii) The accused is sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 8 years u/s 121A IPC and also a fine of Rs. 5,000/- in default further imprisonment of 1 year.
- iii) The accused is sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 5 years u/s 468 IPC and also a fine of Rs. 5,000/- in default further imprisonment of 1 year.
- iv) The accused is sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 8 years u/s 18 of the UA(P) Act, 1967 and also a fine of Rs. 10,000/- in default further imprisonment of 1 year.
- v) The accused is sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 8 years u/s 20 of the UA(P) Act, 1967 and also a fine of Rs. 10,000/- in default further imprisonment of 1 year.

3. The sentences shall run concurrently and the period already suffered in custody in connection with this case shall be set off.

4. The accused Asem Ibotombi Singh @ Angou was arrested by the NIA on 28.05.2012 from Odisha and has been lodged in the Central Jail, Guwahati, Assam since then.
