Appellate Court upholds the conviction of Juvenile in NIA case

The Ld. Court of Additional Sessions Judge-01, Patiala House Court, New Delhi (Appellate Court) on 10.08.2016 pronounced the judgement in Criminal Appeal No.65/2014 filed by the Juvenile and upheld the judgement of Juvenile Justice Board-01, New Delhi awarding a three-year term to juvenile at a special home in NIA case RC-09/2011/NIA/DLI (Delhi High Court Blast case). The Ld. Court dismissed the appeal of Juvenile and found him guilty under various sections of the unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, Indian Penal Code and Explosive Substances Act for various offences including criminal conspiracy for terrorists Act and waging war against the Government of India.

2. On 07.09.2011, a powerful bomb blast took place near the reception Counter between gate no.4&5 of Delhi High Court which resulted in the death of 15 and injuries to 79 persons as well as extensive damage to property of Delhi High Court. After its registration, the case was transferred to NIA for investigation and after investigation, charge sheets were filed against accused Wasim Akram Malik, Amir Abbas Dev, Amir Ali Kamal, Junaid Akram Malik, Shakir Hussain Sheikh and Abu Bilal@Gulam Sarwar and a juvenile under various sections of law. Trial of the main case is under progress before the Special Court of NIA, New Delhi whereas the juvenile was tried before the Juvenile Justice Board-01, New Delhi.

3. The Juvenile Justice Board, New Delhi convicted the Juvenile for commission of offences under sections 120-B IPC r/w Section 121/121-A/122/123/ 307/323/ 325/302/436/440 IPC, Section 4&5 of Explosive Substances Act and Section 16,18,20,38,39 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act and sent the juvenile to Special home for three (3) years.

4. The juvenile filed the appeal against the judgement of JJB which has been dismissed by appellate Court on 10.08.2016 which found him guilty of the conspiracy U/s 120-B IPC for the offences U/s 121/121-A/122/123/323/325/307/302/436/440 of IPC, Sections 16 & 18 of UA(P) Act and Sections 4/5&6 of Explosive Substances Act.
