Annual Conference of Chiefs of States ATS/STF

The 02-day 'Annual Conference of Chiefs of State ATS/STF' organized by NIA at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi concluded today (15/10/2019) with Shri G Kishan Reddy, Hon'ble MoS (Home), Govt. of India gracing the Valedictory Session as Chief Guest. Gen. Bipin Rawat, Chief of Army Staff was also present at this occasion as Guest of honour.

2. Shri G. Kishan Reddy in his address, reaffirmed the Government's commitment to fight terrorism and all its manifestations. He highlighted the importance of State Police in tackling terrorism as first responder in the event of any terrorist attack. He stressed upon the closer co-operation and synergy between the State police forces and central agencies. He also reassured the delegates from the States that the Central Government is committed to capacity building of the State police forces in the area of terrorist investigation cases.

3. DG, NIA in his speech, presented the summary of the deliberations held during the two-day conference. He expressed his satisfaction over the professional discussions and presentations made during different sessions.

The Conference was organised by NIA with a view to strengthen the partnership between State Police Organisations and different Central Agencies for a Comprehensive approach to tackle the menace of terrorism. During the conference, 07 sessions on relevant issues related to terror crime investigation such as terror funding, radicalization, prosecution and cyber forensics were organized.
