NIA Conducts Searches at Two locations in Kozhikode Maoist Case.

(RC-04/2019/NIA/KOC)

On 1st May, 2020, NIA conducted searches in the houses of suspects Vijith Vijayan and Abhilash, both associated with proscribed terrorist organization CPI (Maoist) at Kozhikode, Kerala. Investigation in the case has revealed that Vijith Vijayan and Abhilash were instrumental in recruiting the accused Allan Shuaib (A-1) and Thwaha (A-2) of RC-04/2019/NIA/KOC as members of the banned outfit.

ii) The case was originally registered on 1st November, 2019 at Pantheerankavu PS, Kozhikode City, Kerala as Crime No. 507/ 2019 u/s 20, 38 and 39 of UA (P) Act against Allan Shuaib (A-1), Thwaha Fasal (A-2) and C. P. Usman (A-3), after A-1 and A-2 were apprehended with documents and propaganda material supporting CPI (Maoist), while they were conducting a party meeting with A-3, who had managed to escape from the scene. The case was re-registered by NIA as RC-04/2019/NIA/KOC on 18.12.2019.

iii) After investigation, NIA filed chargesheet against Allan Shuaib (A-1) and Thwaha Fasal (A-2) and the absconding accused C. P. Usman (A-3) on 27.04.2020.

iv) During searches, several digital devices including 8 mobile phones, 7 SIM cards, 2 memory cards, 1 laptop, 7 pen drives and 1 voice recorder, 9 books and numerous documents supporting left-wing extremism and CPI (Maoist) have been seized.

v) The suspects are being examined and further investigation in the case continues.
