3. (a) **Suspected Offence:**

On 11.03.2026, PS Litan received credible information that some persons suspected to be Tangkhul Volunteers came with arms to a poppy field located at the Thawai Kuki Hill Range (Mapithel Hill Range) and destroyed poppy plants and burnt down some of huts in the poppy field. Further, exchange of firing also took place between Tangkhul Volunteers and people of the village Thawai Kuki and adjoining villages. In this incident, 04 persons went missing out of which 02 were later found and rescued. However, during search operations on 12.03.2026, the two other missing persons were found dead.

The Central Government received information regarding registration of FIR No. 09(3)2026 dated 11.03.2026 by Manipur Police at PS-Litan, District Ukhrul, Manipur under section 140, 118, 3(5) of BNS, 2023, section 18(b) of NDPS Act and section 25(1-C) of Arms Act, 1959 and later added section 103 of BNS, 2023 and sections 16, 18 & 20 of UA(P) Act, 1967 pertaining to some persons, suspected to be Tangkhul volunteers, who came with arms to a poppy field located at the Thawai Kuki Hill Range (Mapithel Hill Range) and destroyed the poppy plants and burnt down some of the huts in the poppy field;

And whereas, exchange of firing also took place between suspected Tangkhul Volunteers and people of the village Thawai Kuki and adjoining villages and in this incident, 04 persons went missing out of which 02 were later found and rescued and during search operations on 12.03.2026, the two other missing persons were found dead;

And whereas, the Central Government is of the opinion that a scheduled offence under the National Investigation Agency Act, 2008 has been committed and the case is related to carrying and using of firearms by suspected cadres of NSCN (IM), a terrorist gang, on a particular group of people with an intention to strike terror and panic in the minds of people and having regard to the gravity of the offence, its national ramifications, and the need to unearth the larger conspiracy, the matter requires thorough investigation by the

National Investigation Agency in accordance with the provisions of the National Investigation Agency Act, 2008;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section 5 of section 6 read with section 8 of the National Investigation Agency Act, 2008, the Central Government has directed the National Investigation Agency to take up investigation of the aforesaid case.

11. First Information contents:

Brief of the case:

On 11/03/2026 at about 09:00 am, received reliable information that on the same day at about 06:30 am, some youths suspected to be Tangkhul volunteers with arms came to the poppy field located at the Thawai Kuki Hill Range (Mapithel Hill Range) and destroyed the poppy plants and burnt down some of the huts in the poppy field. Further, it is also learnt that the Tangkhul volunteers fired a few rounds in the air and due to the firing, some persons who were nearby ran away from the area. On learning of the firing in the area, village volunteers of Thawai Kuki and adjoining villages also started firing and exchange of firing took place for some time. After the incident of firing, 04 (four) persons were found missing. Later on, they were identified as (i) Thangminlen Baite of Mongneljang village, (ii) Letginthang Haokip of Thawai Kuki village, (iii) Thengin Baite of Thawai Kuki village and (iv) Thangboimang Khongsai of Shangkai Kuki village. Letginthang Haokip was later found at Thawai kuki village with injuries on his body. Subsequently he was evacuated to Saikul PHC for medical treatment. After some time, Thangminlen Baite was found and rescued from Leingangching area. Search was conducted, however, the other two persons could not be found. Accordingly, a suo-motu case under FIR No. 9(3)2026/LTN-PS U/s 140/118(3)(5) BNS, U/s 18(b) ND & PS Act & Us 25 (1-C) A. Act has been registered for investigation.
