Seizure of FICN of face value of Rs.1,84,500/- at Tumkur District of Karnataka

On 18th March, 2019, Tumkur town police seized Fake Indian Currency Notes (FICN) of face value of Rs. 1,04,500/- from the possession of two persons at Tumkur on the basis of information shared by NIA, Mumbai.

2. Acting on the tip-off, local police apprehended three persons viz Tammayya Honnappa s/o late Honnappa, 42 years r/o Macheri, Kaduru Taluka, Chikmagalur, Afroze s/o Yakub Sab, 44 years, Azadnagar, Gauribidanur, Chikkaballapura and Maruthi s/o Sanjeevayya, 37 years, r/o Hulikunte Village, Koratagere Taluka, Tumkur. They were found in possession of 52 fake Indian currency notes all in the denomination of Rs. 2000/- and 1 FICN in the denomination of Rs. 500/-, collectively having face value of Rs. 1,04,500/-.

3. During further follow-up searches and raids, on 19/03/2019, local police seized FICN of the face value of Rs.80,000/- from the possession of Mrs. Jayamma, r/o Peenya, Bengaluru, who was also arrested.

4. An FIR No. 47/2019 dated 19/03/2019 has been registered at PS Tumkur Town u/s 489-A, 489-B & 489-C, Sec. 120B of IPC & investigation is in progress.
