



**NIA Conducts Searches at Multiple Locations in Telangana and Arrests Three Accused in Peddabayalu CPI(Maoist) Recruitment Case (RC-02/2022/NIA/HYD)**

Today (23.06.2022), NIA conducted searches at 03 locations in Telangana in the districts of Ranga Reddy, Medak and Secunderabad and arrested three accused in RC-02/2022/NIA/HYD.

2. The case pertains to the conspiracy and recruitment of one college student, into the fold of proscribed terrorist organization CPI(Maoist) by the leaders/members of Chaitanya Mahila Sangham (CMS), a frontal organization of CPI(Maoist). The case was initially registered as FIR.No.01/2022 dated 03.01.2022 at Peddabayalu PS, Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh. NIA had re-registered the case on 03.06.2022 and taken over the investigation.

3. During the searches conducted today, incriminating materials including digital devices have been seized.

4. Based on the searches conducted today, NIA has arrested the three accused for their involvement in motivating and recruiting youth for the proscribed organization CPI(Maoist). The details of arrested accused are as follows :

- a) Dongari Devendra, r/o Gandhi Nagar, Parwathapur, Peerzadiguda, Ghatkesar (M), Ranga Reddy District, Telangana
- b) Dubasi Swapna, r/o Hayathnagar, Ranga Reddy District, Telangana
- c) Chukka Shilpa, r/o Khairatabad, Hyderabad, Telangana

5. Further investigation in the case continues.
