



NIA conducts searches in Mizoram in the pilferage of explosives from India to Myanmar case (RC-09/2022/NIA/DLI)

1. Today (13.09.2022), NIA conducted searches at two (02) locations in Aizawl district of Mizoram in case no. RC-09/2022/NIA/DLI pertaining to recovery of 2400 kgs of explosives including 1000 detonators and 4500 metres of detonating fuse wire, cash- Rs. 73,500/- and 9,35,500/- Kyat (Myanmar Currency).

2. The case was initially registered at Tipa Police Station, District-Saiha, Mizoram as FIR no. 01/2022 dated 21.01.2022 and later re-registered by NIA on 21.03.2022.

Investigations have revealed that the consignment of explosives was meant for the Myanmar based outfit, Chin National Front (CNF) which has been accumulating arms, ammunition and explosives for armed struggle against the Government of Myanmar.

Three accused, including one Myanmar national, were arrested in this case and chargesheeted by NIA on 19th April, 2022.

3. During the searches conducted today, incriminating material, including mobile phone, bank documents etc. have been seized from the premises of suspects.

4. Further investigations in the case are in progress.
