



NIA conducts searches at Multiple Locations in Rajasthan in PFI Conspiracy Case

Today (12.01.2023), NIA conducted searches at 9 locations of Jaipur (04), Kota (04) and Sawai Madhopur (01) districts of Rajasthan in NIA case no. RC-41/2022/NIA/DLI.

The case is related to secret information received from reliable sources that Sadiq Sarraf S/o Samar R/o Shyopuriyon Ki Masjid, Talabpada, PS Kotwali, District Baran, Rajasthan and Mohammed Asif S/o Late Ashfaq Mirza, R/o Retipada, Sangod, district Kota of Popular Front of India (PFI), alongwith officer bearers, members & cadres of PFI, are indulging in unlawful activities and through their provocative utterances and activities promoting violent acts, are promoting enmity and hatred among different religious groups in India. Their inflammatory speeches and lectures on various platforms inciting and disrupting sovereignty and territorial integrity of India. In pursuance to conspiracy, accused, Sadiq Sarraf and Mohammad Asif and unknown others are radicalizing Muslims youth to commit unlawful activities and terrorists acts in various parts of India, including State of Rajasthan.

3. During the searches conducted today, digital devices (mobile phones, SIM cards), sharp edged knives, and incriminating material, literature/posters etc. have been seized.

4. Further investigations in the case are in progress.
