



NIA Arrests another accused in Rajasthan PFI case

1. Continuing its operations against PFI activist cadres involved in conspiracies to commit violent and unlawful acts/activities, NIA has arrested another accused on 10.2.2023 from Jaipur, Rajasthan.
2. The suspect was identified as Mohammad Sohail, who was found to have been actively involved in PFI's criminal conspiracy to disturb peace and spread communal hatred and enmity. Son of Mohammad Salim, a resident of H No-13, Sector 12, Murshid Nagar, PS- Savina, Udaipur, Rajasthan, Mohd. Sohail, alongwith PFI cadres/members, have conspired to radicalize Muslim youth to commit violent and unlawful activities.
3. Earlier, NIA had arrested two accused namely Sadiq Sarraf and accused Mohammed Asif in the case. The case was initially registered on 19.09.2022 at NIA Hqrs, New Delhi.
4. This arrest has taken the total arrests to 03 in this case.
