



NIA Files Supplementary Charge Sheet in case RC-39/2018/NIA/DLI,
Grenade attack on PS Maqsudan, Jalandhar

NIA, today (30.08.2019) filed a Supplementary Charge Sheet in the NIA Special Court, Mohali, Punjab, in Case no. RC-39/2018/NIA/DLI which relates to 4 Hand Grenade explosions that took place on 14th Sept 2018 in the premises of Police Station Maqsudan, Jalandhar, Punjab. In this attack one policeman had received splinter injuries in his chest. Initially, a case FIR No. 163/2018 dated 15-09-2018 was registered by Punjab Police at PS Division-1, Jalandhar, Punjab. Subsequently, the case was taken over by NIA for investigation.

2. Earlier, on 6th May 2019, NIA had filed first Charge Sheet in the case against two accused persons viz. Fazil Bashir Pinchoo and Shahid Quyoom, both residents of Awantipora, Pulwama, J&K who were studying at the St. Soldier Institute, Jalandhar, Punjab.
3. Investigation has established that Fazil Bashir Pinchoo and Shahid Quyoom along with two other accused persons namely Rouf Ahmed Mir and Ummer Ramzan both residents of village Dadsara, Awantipora, Pulwama, J&K, had carried out grenade attack at the premises of PS Maqsudan, Jalandhar, Punjab on 14th Sept 2018 on the directions of Zakir Rashid Bhat @ Zakir Musa, the Self-Styled Chief of terrorist outfit Ansar Ghazwat-ul-Hind (AGH).
4. Investigation further revealed that Fazil Bashir Pinchoo, Shahid Quyoom, Rouf Ahmed Mir, and Ummer Ramzan @ Gazi had targeted PS Maqsudan, Jalandhar in association with Amir Nazir Mir and Rasik Ahmed Mir, both residents of village Dadsara, PS Awantipora, Pulwama under a conspiracy hatched by Zakir Rashid Bhat @ Zakir Musa, self-styled chief of AGH, to target security forces' installations throughout the country. All the above persons were cadres of Ansar Ghazwat-ul-Hind (AGH), a Kashmir based terrorist outfit with a Pan-Islamic ideology.

5. The Charge-Sheet has been filed in the Special NIA Court, Mohali, Punjab against Amir Nazir Mir u/s 120B, 121, 121A, 201, 307 of IPC, Section 18, 18B, 20, 23 of the UA(P)A, and section 6 of

Explosive Substances Act. The charges have been abated in respect of Zakir Rashid Bhat @ Zakir Musa on account of his death in an encounter with security forces in the intervening night of 23/24 May 2019 at village Dadsara, Awantipora, Kashmir.
