 - कॉलम 8 में आशुलिपिक ग्रेड "डी" तथा अवर श्रेणी लिपिक के पद के लिए "किसी मान्यताप्राप्त बोर्ड से मैट्रिकुलेशन अथवा समतुल्य" के स्थान पर "किसी मान्यताप्राप्त बोर्ड से 10+2 पास अथवा समतुल्य" प्रतिस्थापित किया जाएगा।
 - कॉलम 12 में प्रवर श्रेणी लिपिक के लिए शीर्ष (iii) के नीचे सीमित विभागीय परीक्षा के लिए "आठ वर्ष की नियमित सेवा वाले अधिकारी" शब्दों के स्थान पर "पांच वर्ष की नियमित सेवा वाले अधिकारी" प्रतिस्थापित किया जाएगा।
 - कॉलम 12 में हेड कांस्टेबल पद के लिए शीर्ष (ii) के नीचे प्रतिनियुक्त अथवा आमेलन निम्नलिखित नोट डाला जाएगा।
नोट 1 : फीडर श्रेणी में विभागीय अधिकारी जो पदोन्नति के लिए सीधे पदोन्नति के क्रम में हैं उन्हें प्रतिनियुक्ति पर नियुक्ति के लिए विचाराधीन नहीं रखा जाएगा।
 - कॉलम 3 में प्रवर श्रेणी लिपिक, आशुलिपिक ग्रेड डी तथा अवर श्रेणी लिपिक पदों के लिए "सामान्य केन्द्रीय सेवाएं समूह ग, अराजपत्रित, गैर मंत्रीय" के स्थान पर "सामान्य केन्द्रीय सेवाएं समूह ग, अराजपत्रित, मंत्रीय" प्रतिस्थापित किया जाएगा।

G.S.R. 815(E).— In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 25 of the National Investigation Agency Act, 2008 (34 of 2008), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Ministry of Home Affairs, National Investigation Agency (Group “C” posts) Recruitment Rules, 2009, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, National Investigation Agency (Group “C” posts) Recruitment Amendment Rules, 2011.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the Ministry of Home Affairs, National Investigation Agency (Group “C” posts) Recruitment Rules, 2009 :—

- (A) In column 8, for the post of Stenographer Grade “D” and Lower Division Clerk (LDCs), for the words “Matriculation from a recognized board or equivalent”, the words “10+2 pass from a recognized board or equivalent” shall be substituted.
- (B) In column 12 for the post of Upper Division Clerk, below the heading (iii) Limited Department Examination, for the words “Officers having eight years of regular service”, the words “Officers having five years of regular service” shall be substituted.
- (C) In column 12, for the post of Head Constable, below the heading (ii) Deputation or Absorption, following Note shall be inserted :—

Note 1 : The department officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration by promotion.

- (D) In column 3 for the posts of Upper Division Clerk, Stenographer Grade “D” and Lower Division Clerk, for the words “General Central Services, Group-C, Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial”, the words “General Central Services, Group-C, Non-Gazetted, Ministerial” shall be substituted.

New Delhi, the 12th November, 2009.

G.S.R. 817 [E] -In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to certain posts in the National Investigation Agency under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. – (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, National Investigation Agency (Group 'C' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2009.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.- The number of posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in the columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications etc.- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. Initial Constitution.- The incumbents of the posts mentioned in the said Schedule who on the date of commencement of these rules are holding the post on regular basis shall be deemed to have been appointed under these rules and the service rendered by them in the said post on regular basis before the said commencement shall be taken into account for deciding their eligibility for promotion to the next higher grade.

5. Disqualification - No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 12th November, 2009

G.S.R. 817(E).— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to certain posts in the National Investigation Agency under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.** – (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, National Investigation Agency (Group 'C' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2009.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.**- The number of posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in the columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications etc.**- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the aforesaid Schedule.
4. **Initial Constitution.**- The incumbents of the posts mentioned in the said Schedule who on the date of commencement of these rules are holding the post on regular basis shall be deemed to have been appointed under these rules and the service rendered by them in the said post on regular basis before the said commencement shall be taken into account for deciding their eligibility for promotion to the next higher grade.

5. Disqualification - No person,-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
- shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
