(a) **Suspected Offence:** Information was received at PS Uri, District Baramulla regarding arrest of LeT militant namely Babar Ali @ Imadullah @ Dujana 313 son of Mohd Hanief resident of village Shakurabad, Tehsil Dipalur, District Okara, Punjab province of Pakistan from Angur Post under the jurisdiction of Police Station Uri in District Baramulla. The accused Babar Ali was the part of the proscribed terrorist organisation LeT, who reached Uri by illegally crossing Line of Control (LOC) on 18.09.2021. In this operation Arms/ Ammunitions / Explosives and other incriminating material was recovered from the possession of accused Babar Ali who was nabbed by the Army on 26.09.2021.

The Central Government has received information regarding registration of an FIR No 99/2021 dated 27.09.2021 at PS Uri, District Baramulla, UT of J&K, under sections 307 of IPC, sections 7, 27 of Arms Act, sections 2 & 3 of EMICO Act, sections 16, 20 & 38 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, relating to arrest of a Pakistani militant, namely Babar Ali @ Imadullah @ Dujana 313 son of Mohd Hanief resident of village Shakurabad, Tehsil Dipalpur, District Okara, Punjab province of Pakistan from Angur Post under the jurisdiction of Police Station Uri in District Baramulla. The accused Babar Ali was the part of the LeT militant group, which reached at Uri sector fencing on 18.09.2021 and was nabbed by the Army on 26.09.2021.

And whereas, the route, through which the aforesaid arrested terrorist infiltrated into the Indian Territory in Uri, is suspected to be the same route that was taken by the terrorists in NIA case RC-14/2016/NIA/DLI (Uri Terrorists attack Case) on 19.09.2016.

And whereas, the Central Government is of the opinion that the Scheduled offence under National Investigation Agency Act, 2008 has been committed and, having regard to the gravity of the offence and its grave ramifications on national security, it is required to be investigated by the National Investigation Agency in accordance with the National Investigation Agency Act, 2008.

Now, therefore the Govt. of India Ministry of Home Affairs, CTCR Division vide order No. 11011/66/2021/NIA dated 29.10.2021, in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (5) of section 6 read with section 8 of the National Investigation Agency Act, 2008, the Central Government hereby directs the National Investigation Agency to take up investigation of the aforesaid case.

The MHA order is attached as **Annexure 'A'** and the copy of the FIR No. 99/2021 dated 27.09.2021 is attached as **Annexure- 'B'**.
